In order to participate in the Carroll Township Spring Clean-up, individuals must provide a valid driver's license with a current address in Carroll Township. **Limit of one pickup load per household.**

#### Items Accepted:

- Tires..... Limit of 4 passenger vehicle tires per household at no charge; \$2 per tire charge for more than four tires disposed. Cash only. Maximum of 8 tires accepted per household.
- Metal..... Free of gas, oil, freon and batteries. Items such as lawn mowers, steel pipe, washers, dryers, stoves, refrigerators and air conditioners.
- Trash..... Items such as furniture, mattresses, wood (**bundled, boxed, bagged, with a 50lb. maximum, no more than 4 feet in length**).

**Electronic items such as computers, computer accessory machines, televisions and microwaves will NOT be accepted this year.**

Please remember to install the street address on your house at the place most visible to the road and on both sides of your mailbox. Use reflective numbers that are 3" high and replace missing or faded numbers. If you live back a long lane, placing a street number sign at the entrance to the driveway helps guide emergency personnel to the proper residence. And remember to keep your driveways trimmed and cleared so that fire and rescue equipment are able to access your property.

## Recreation Board News:

A \$57,200 matching funds grant was received from DCNR for improvements at the Valley Park. The grant will be used to complete the infrastructure for the park which will include installation of electric, water, sewer and a comfort facility.

Other goals, not part of the grant, for 2015 for the Valley Road Park include the installation of batting cages, expansion of the walking trails, installation of fitness equipment along the walking trail and a pavilion. Many of these projects will be completed via a partnership with the Boy Scouts who are completing their community projects to earn their Eagle designation, one of the highest ranks in Boy Scouts.
